



Fountain Dew

Why leave it to the sound of babbling water alone to deliver the peaceful feeling we want from a fountain? The Mission-style lines of this custom-built feature—named Fallingwater, natch—set a tranquil mood all on their own. Based on drawings by interior designer Matty Bennett, Forward Fabrication made the six-foot-tall raw steel structure with twin waterfalls and (thank you!) a maintenance-free system, then used sea salt, vinegar and lemon juice for the rusted patina. Crowds at the Indiana Flower & Patio Show ogled the \$5,000 creation at the BC Architectural Concepts display, and the company stashed it after the show, along with a smaller version—both are still for sale. 773-9933, www.bcarchconcepts.com | TR
